










Medical Checkup Visual Schedule

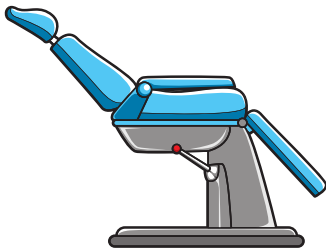
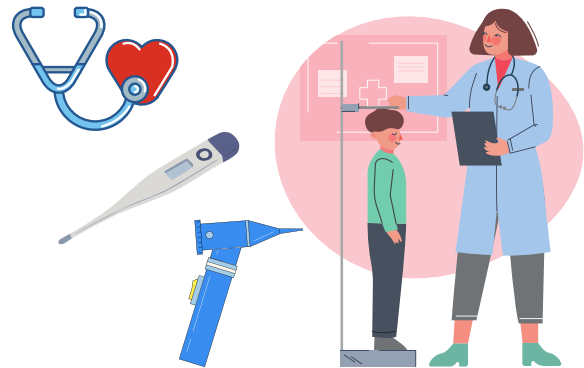
Soon I have to go to _____ for _____.
